# Measures for reopening CEPC Toilet Facilities in Park Square and Park Crescent Garden Areas post Covid-19

### Introduction

These guidelines have been produced following the easing of Covid-19 lockdown restrictions, leading to increased CEPC Garden use and subsequent demand to re-open the garden toilet facilities and prevent fouling of the gardens. There are risks to both garden users and staff in re-opening the toilets. Whilst we have implemented certain measures to reduce those risks, please note they are not eliminated. It is important these measures are followed. Please respect our staff as they are here for your own and others' safety.

### Use of toilet facilities in CEPC Gardens

1. Avoid using the toilet facilities where possible.
2. Use at your own risk.
3. Each of the facilities are cleaned daily. Their use is being split to reduce the number of people using each facility. They are periodically monitored during the day.
4. The toilet facilities will be closed during cleaning and/or may be closed at no notice if determined by the CEPC.
5. Maintain a safe distance of 2 metres from others when entering, waiting, or leaving the toilet facilities.
6. If upon entry to the toilet you establish that someone is using the facility, please use an alternative toilet or wait outside, keeping 2 metres apart from others.
7. Avoid touching surfaces where possible and do not touch your face.
8. Before leaving the facility **WASH YOUR HANDS** with soap and water for at least 20 seconds and dry thoroughly with paper towels.
9. Dispose of paper towels in the bins provided.
10. Please respect other garden users and CEPC staff.

We are aiming for the CEPC toilet facilities to be open for use as follows:

Park Crescent 07:30 – 13:00

Park Square 13:00 – 18:00

We apologise if they are not open during these times due to measures to protect safety.

We assume that CEPC garden users have adhered to the government advice about not entering the CEPC gardens if they have coronavirus symptoms, so it is not included above.
